

Construction Progress

Slow Going...

- Some work has slowed down simply because of funding. We are committed to paying as we go so there is no debt outstanding. To get back on track quickly, roughly \$250,000 is needed so the Food Pantry can open by summer.
- The fire sprinkler contractor is expected to do a walk-through at the beginning of April. This will help us to know the actual cost and give us an estimated timeline. This part is crucial to get the Food Pantry phase open by summer.
- Outside work is going forward on Arthur street. We think our appearance in the neighborhood should be pleasing to the eye. We are working to get the front area cleaned up, concrete poured, and set things up for some landscaping.



Our new Food Pantry area is going to be a great space for serving our guests. Have we mentioned - there will not be ANY stairs in our pantry distribution area? As trivial as this may sound, it can be a major issue for many of our physically challenged and senior guests.

Pantry Trends n Such:

- March was riddled with fun weather, which seemed to land on Thursdays. This reduced the number of families we served to an average of 150, well below our weekly usual of 200.
- Food donations from local stores were a little lighter in March than normal. We were able to purchase food from Ridley's during their case lot sale, which did off-set the lack of donations.
- We cannot express how blessed we are with this team of volunteers! More than 70 people, most from the community, give more than 160 hours EVERY WEEK to serve our community.

We collect donations from 14 different grocers and convenience stores every week. Each month we will celebrate one of our these incredible partners.



Food Pantry Opportunities

There are a few ways to serve:

Wednesdays, 8 am - 11:30 am

Food is delivered from our 14 stores as well as from the Idaho Foodbank. Unloading, sorting, organizing and building food boxes takes place on this day.

Thursdays, 10 am to 11 am

Additional food deliveries from some of the same stores. Unloading, sorting and organizing takes place here.

Thursdays, 3:30 to 6 pm

Food is distributed to the community. Most 'jobs' deal with serving the guest as well as carrying boxes to their vehicles.
