# Street Reach - Connecting Resources

Street Reach is our outreach ministry to those living on the streets, in parking lots, in parks, under bridges and more. We look to make a connection with them, offer some simple resources, and work to connect them to permanent housing and other support from within the community.

Our last day out in November ended with a very busy time out on the streets, connecting with 8 people in vehicles and camp trailers. Of those individuals, 3 were new to Street Reach. This does not include the 4 other locations along the river where encampments were but no one was home.

This is a very important ministry of Valley Mission, especially as we begin this winter season. We have added items such as hand warmers and blankets to the resources, along with additional pairs of socks.

One of the successes this week was connecting 'Sam' with resources to get his window fixed in his car. He had been living in his car with a broken window and the weather was turning cold. After our visit with him, we were able to connect him with Cars for Christ at Grace Lutheran Church. We acquired the part and the team went to work. To his surprise it was nothing serious and only required some minor work, which they did on the spot. He now is warm and secure in his vehicle. What a blessing to be in a community where collaboration works well!

We also completed another training for Street Reach in November which will help us build a 2nd team that can go out each week.
