## Street Reach

We are thrilled to announce our newest program Street Reach. This ministry takes the programs and services we offer directly to the people who need it most.

Street reach is helping us to build trust with our neighbors. For those struggling with mental health or long-term addiction, seeking help can be a huge challenge. Street Reach provides a mobile service to reach out to these unsheltered individuals.

Trusting strangers for help or being around large groups of people can trigger responses of fear, panic and stress - responses programmed through a lifetime of abuse, neglect and trauma. Unable to seek help, many of these individuals become the "unsheltered homeless", living in tents or abandoned buildings, under bridges, in wooded areas, and in unsafe and unsanitary conditions. Valley Mission's Street Reach program locates these unsheltered individuals and provides a number of services including, but not limited to: an introduction to Valley Mission and community services available, food and water, clothing, winter gear (hats, gloves, coats, etc), summer gear (insect repellent, sunscreen, etc), prayer, encouragement, and human kindness.
