In mid June we were able to begin moving forward with construction on Arthur St. Never has equipment sounded so good! Crews were busy installing a utility door and moving 60 tons of gavel into the old swimming pools and hot tubs. This is the final step of our demolition and will position us to get started quickly for infrastructure install - water, electrical, mechanical.



So what's next? Phase 1 is all about the Food Pantry. Infrastructure for the main floor and stub-in for the second floor will be done, and then we'll focus our building attention on framing the Food Pantry area. And yes, we'll prep the laundromat area, but our focus is really to get the Pantry built so that it can be opened by this fall/winter. With that done, we can also re-open the Warming Shelter in the old Food Pantry space, also known as the Family Room at First Baptist. So now you can see how it's all connected.
