Building Update

34 yards of concrete poured in just under 3 hours - amazing!

This area is where all the plumbing and parts of the electrical comes into the building. This has been months in the making and we are excited to see this portion of Phase 1 get completed and ready for the next work. The final piece of plumbing will be installed in the old racquetball court area with the fire riser and lines that will feed our sprinkler system throughout the building. Then we can move onto some framing and more electrical.

This is really where the visible 'progress' begins to show. Our focus for this phase is to get all the infrastructure in so that we can open the Food Pantry in it's new space by this fall. So far, we are on track to see that happen. God is so GOOD!!!

What Do You Do?

It was a year ago that we brought Jessica on as our first full time staff to transition into the place of being Valley Mission's Executive Director. Over the last year we have been asked what it is exactly that Jessica does for Valley Mission. While the list of her tasks would be exhaustive to write about, we decided to use her anniversary to give you an update on a handful of accomplishments Valley Mission has made because of her employment.

1. Development Street Reach and Warming Shelter programs. If you have ever been a part of program development you know that developing a comprehensive program with training is a big undertaking. The development of two comprehensive programs in the last year has made it possible for us to reach more people right away.
2. Over the last year 22 policies have been written and put in front of the board. From these policies 54 procedures were created that will allow our buildings and programs to run smoothly as we grow.
3. While we had a LOT of fantastic partnerships in place before Jessica's arrival, Jessica has not only worked to keep strengthening those but also brought in many new relationships with donors, businesses, organizations and city entities. One such relationship has been with our police department.
4. Church outreach has blossomed over the last year as we have been able to send Jessica to speak to other churches on Sundays. This is helping bring our fellow believers onboard with the vision God gave us.
5. Launched a City ID program that will help our neighbors and guests secure more permanent identification.

While many of Jessica's responsibilities are not seen by the masses, the impact they will have over the life of Valley Mission is vital to our long term success.
