Breaking Down Your Gift

Valley Mission invites you to partner with us to serve our homeless and hungry neighbors. We welcome donations of all kinds. Below are a few options. To give please log onto valleymission.org and click on the donate tab. Scroll to the bottom of the donation page and put in your donation amount and desired frequency. You may also call us at any time to make a donation over the phone or set up a tour to learn more about what we do in our community.

Financial giving options:

- Become a monthly donor. For \$25 a month you will support the lifesaving work of Valley Mission.
- Give to our building fund. Donate a cinder block for \$5000
- Furnish a bedroom for \$1000
- Support the laundry mat for \$100

Warming Shelter Run Costs:

You may donate any amount you choose. Here are some specific amounts and how they help:

- Provide food, shelter, and case management to 1 person = \$51.69
- Provide food, shelter, and case management to 2 people = \$103.38
- Provide food, shelter, and case management to 4 people = \$206.76
- Provide food, shelter, and case management to 7 people = \$361.83
- Provide food, shelter, and case management to 20 people = \$1,033.80

Your donation goes toward more than just a bed for our homeless neighbours to sleep in, and a warm meal for them to eat, but also includes case management, job search help, and the priceless potential of finding new life through an encounter with Christ.
