The goal is to create a minimum of 2 teams that will go out weekly to meet these neighbors, bring supplies, direct them to resources, and offer them hope.

We will be selective in who will be placed on the teams, but there are other ways to be involved. We will cover all of the opportunities at the training.

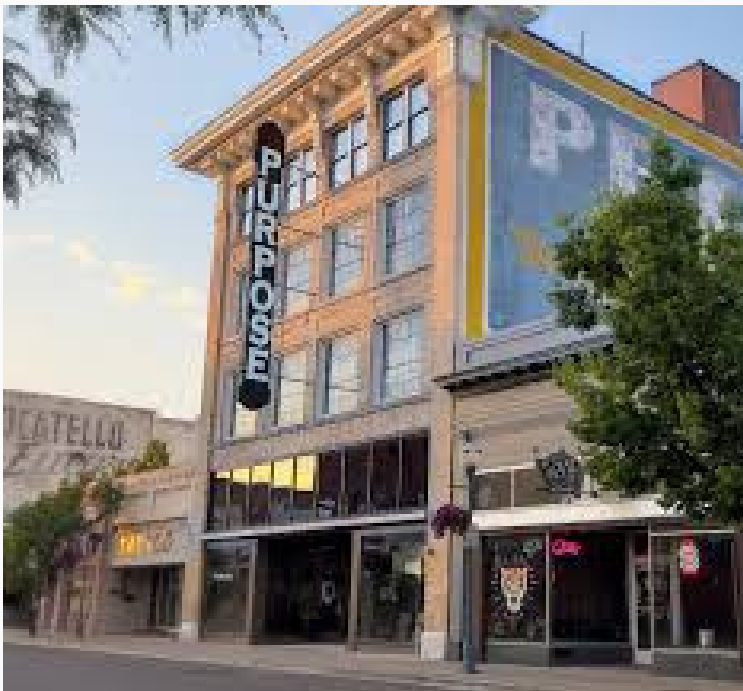
