

The gospel of John chapters 12-21 cover the last week of Jesus' life.

Passover was held at Lazarus' Home

[1] Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.



Passover



Exodus 12:1-6 KJVS

[1] And the Lord spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying,

[2] This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.

[3] Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:

[4] And if the household be too little for the lamb, let him and his neighbour next unto his house take it according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the lamb.

[5] Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats:

[6] And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.

On tenth day, the family had to pick a lamb without blemish and spend time with the lamb. On the 14th day the lamb was slaughtered.

Moses and the prophets spoke of Jesus. Jesus was the perfect sacrifice. We are not to go back to Jewish laws.

Mary Anoints Jesus at Dinner

John 12:2-3 KJVS

[2] There they made him a supper; and Martha served: but Lazarus was one of them that sat at the table with him.

[3] Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment.

The ointment was worth a year's salary. Mary made a costly sacrifice. There was no limit on her desire to worship Jesus. Jesus was worth the sacrifice, Mary valued Jesus. Mary did not understand all that she was doing. Mary always sat at Jesus' feet.



Judas Iscariot Complained

John 12:4-6

John 12:5-6 KJVS

[5] Why was not this ointment sold for three hundred pence, and given to the poor?

[6] This he said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein.

Jesus knew that Judas was a thief and would betray him.

Judas did not value Jesus, his heart was far from Jesus.


Judas was a Decepticon. He valued money.

Judas had an agenda.

John 13:2 KJVS



Judas was a disciple and a thief who kept for himself some of the money that was put in the bag.



Jesus Told Judas to Leave Mary Alone

John 12:7 Therefore Jesus said, "Leave her alone, so that she may keep it for the day of My burial.

John 12:8 "For you always have the poor with you, but you do not always have Me." (NASB2020)

John 12:7-8 KJVS

[7] Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this. [8] For the poor always ye have with you; but me ye have not always.

Mark 14:6-9 KJVS

[6] And Jesus said, Let her alone; why trouble ye her? she hath wrought a good work on me. [7] For ye have the poor with you always, and whosoever ye will ye may do them good: but me ye have not always. [8] She hath done what she could: she is come beforehand to anoint my body to the burying. [9] Verily I say unto you, Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached throughout the whole world, this also that she hath done shall be spoken of for a memorial of her.
