WORD OF THE WEEK

Hebrew

שָׂרָה (yāraš) — Strong's H3423

Meaning:

- To possess
- To inherit
- To take ownership
- To dispossess previous occupants

Usage: Used when Israel was commanded to take the land God promised them. This word implies removal of resistance and legal transfer of territory.

Strong's H270 — (ʾāḥaz) אָחַז

Meaning:

- To seize
- To grasp
- To take hold
- To secure firmly

Usage:

Describes fastening onto something so it cannot be removed. Often used in contexts of gripping authority or territory.

Greek

πραγματεύομαι (pragmateuomai) — Strong's G4231

Meaning:

- To do business
- To trade
- To put money or resources to work
- To gain by activity

Usage:

- Appears in Luke 19:13. Describes faithful productivity and increase while awaiting the return of the master.

Webster's Dictionary:

- To possess or take control
- To hold for use
- To employ or engage
- To reside or fill
- To carry on business



CONFESSIONS & PRAYER POINTS

1. Every spirit of passivity assigned to make me watch instead of rule, I revoke your influence; I rise and take my God-ordained territory now (Luke 19:13).

9. Weariness attempting to evict me from consistency, you lose; I stand and keep standing (Galatians 6:9).
