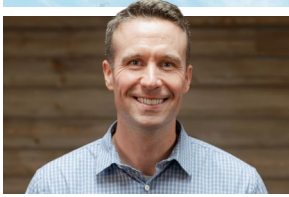

DAY OF PRAYER & FASTING

Our next day of Prayer and Fasting will be **Wednesday, February 4**. On that day, we invite you to join us as a church in skipping one or more meals and focusing that time on prayer. If you are unable to skip a meal for health reasons, try fasting from something else (television, social media, etc.).

As we prepare for our Global Ministry Conference on February 22 – March 1, one of the most important things we can do is to pray. Prayer is the foundation of everything we do in Global Ministry. Jesus taught us to pray that God would send workers into his harvest (Matt. 9:37-38; Luke 10:2). In his New Testament letters, Paul often requested the churches to pray for his gospel ministry (Rom. 15:30-32; Eph. 6:18-20; Col. 4:2-4). Join us as we follow the Bible's instructions to pray for the spread of the gospel throughout the world:

- Pray God would open our eyes to what He is doing in bringing people to faith in Christ around the world.
- Pray our Global Ministry Partners will be refreshed and encouraged by their time with us at the conference.
- Pray for our three Unreached People Groups: the Aweer (East Africa), the M-People (East Asia), and the Silk Road People (Central Asia).
- Pray PCCers will recognize their calling as ambassadors of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20).
- Pray God will use the conference to raise up the next generation of Global Ministry Partners.
