LON SOLOMON'S BEST OF THE HOLY LAND TOUR

OCTOBER 11-19, 2026

October 11, 2026 - Depart USA.

October 12, 2026 - Arrive Israel - We then travel to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

October 13, 2026 - Today, we have a full day in store for us. After breakfast, we will visit the site where Jesus ate with Peter after the resurrection and we will have a time of worship and devotions here from John 21 to begin our day. We next proceed to the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. We will take time here for a sermon from Lon. After this, we will drive to the excavated ancient city of Capernaum, where Jesus established the headquarters for his three-year public ministry. We will stand in the very synagogue where Jesus preached. Time will be taken here for another sermon. We will then visit the ancient boat from the time of Christ, found in the mud of the Sea of Galilee during the drought of 1986. Following this, we will sail across the magnificent Sea of Galilee and pause in the middle to reflect on Jesus' miracles that were performed on this Sea. We then settle in at a local restaurant for a delicious lunch. After lunch, we will go down to the Jordan River to baptize those who desire to do this. After a full day, we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

October 14, 2026 - After a restful night, we rise to enjoy a fabulous Israeli breakfast at our hotel. Following breakfast, we drive into the central Israeli highlands that formed the nucleus of the northern kingdom of Israel in the days after King Solomon. From here, we proceed to Mt. Carmel, site of the prophet Elijah's showdown with the prophets of Baal. Time will be taken here to read and reflect on this incredible biblical event as recorded in 1 Kings 18. Next we ride to Caesarea, home of Pontius Pilate, location where the Apostle Paul was imprisoned (Acts 25-26) and the city where the Gospel was first taken to the Gentiles in the person of Cornelius, the Roman centurion (Acts 10). Caesarea was one of the great cities of the Roman world, so we will spend time exploring the extensive excavations here by the beautiful Mediterranean Sea. We will also take time in the amphitheater for devotions and prayer. After an exciting day of biblical challenge, we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.



The Sea of Galilee

October 15, 2026 - We begin our morning by going to the amazing excavations just south of the Sea of Galilee at the ancient city of Bet Shean. Bet Shean was a significant city in Palestine since the time of Abraham and is mentioned in the records of Pharaoh Thutmose III as a city he conquered on his Canaan campaign in 1468 BC. It figures prominently in a tragic episode from the Bible, when the Philistines took the beheaded bodies of King Saul and his son Jonathan, and hung them on the city wall of Bet Shean (1 Sam. 31:8-10). Under Greek and later Roman rule, Bet Shean became a wealthy and influential city, as evidenced by the impressive remains from this period, including a theater that rivals the one at Caesarea. We then will sit on the Mount of Olives and look over at the breath-taking Temple Mount and Old City. Lon will share a message here focusing on the many biblical events that happened on the Mount of Olives. After a full day, we will have dinner and overnight at our deluxe hotel.

October 16, 2026 - After a great breakfast, we will travel to the private courtyard at the Garden of Gethsemane, overlooking the Temple Mount. There will be time here for worship, devotions, and prayer led by Lon. From here, we will walk across the road into the Garden of Gethsemane itself, where we will see olive trees that were actually alive on the night Jesus prayed here. From here we go to the Wailing Wall and the Temple Mount. We will see "The Beautiful Gate" where the events of Acts 3 took place. Lon will share a devotional here. Then, situation permitting, we will proceed onto the Temple Mount where we will discuss with us the rebuilding of the Jewish Temple and its implications for the Second

Coming of our Lord Jesus. We then visit the Pool of Bethesda (John 5), where Lon will share a sermon. After a great day, dinner and overnight at our deluxe hotel.

October 17, 2026 - After another amazing Israeli breakfast, we will visit the Israeli Museum. Here, we will not only see the Dead Sea Scrolls, but also a number of other archaeological treasures that wonderfully authenticate the veracity of the Bible. Among the artifacts we will see are (1) the oldest written biblical quotation in existence, from 650 BC; (2) the bone-box (ossuary) of Caiaphas, the high priest who condemned Jesus; (3) the Tel-Dan stele, where we find the only mention of David's name outside of the Bible; (4) the original Pontius Pilate stone from Caesarea; and many other incredible finds. Lon will walk us through and explain to us the significance of each of these artifacts and how they confirm the authenticity of the written Word of God. We will also visit the model of the ancient city of Jerusalem as it looked at the time of Jesus. Seeing this and having our guides explain it to us in depth will give you an understanding of the layout of ancient Jerusalem that will help put into perspective every site we will visit in Jerusalem. After lunch, we begin the culminating highlight of our time in Jerusalem: our visit to Golgotha and the Garden Tomb. Plenty of time will be taken here for reflection and meditation as well as a time of worship and a special communion service. Tonight, we have a special celebration banquet with Israeli believers in Jesus at our hotel in Jerusalem and overnight at our deluxe hotel.

October 18, 2026 - After breakfast, we leave Jerusalem and head out for an exciting day around the Dead Sea. We first head south down the coast of the Dead Sea to the Qumran caves, where the famous Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in 1947. We saw these scrolls at the Israeli Museum in Jerusalem but here we will see their resting place for almost 2000 years until 1947. Next we will drive by the beautiful oasis of En Gedi, where David found refuge in his flight from King Saul (1 Sam 24). Then we will visit Masada, the fortress of Herod the Great. In 70 AD, the last of the Jewish revolutionaries against Rome fled here after Jerusalem and the Temple had been destroyed. They defended this fortress for three years against the Roman 10th legion, eventually all committing suicide rather than fall into the hands of the Romans. After this, we will head to the southern end of the Dead Sea to the ancient area of Sodom and Gomorrah. Time will be taken here for you to swim in the Dead Sea and you will discover that you are positively unsinkable! At this point, our group will divide. Those of us who are going on to the Mt. Sinai and Petra extensions will continue driving south to the town of Eilat. Those of us who are not going to Sinai will return to Jerusalem for dinner and transfer to the airport.

October 19, 2026 - After a great return flight, we arrive back in America with precious memories of the Holy Land to cherish forever.

MT. SINAI AND PETRA EXTENSIONS (October 18-22, 2026)

October 18, 2026 - After our inspiring time in the Holy Land, those taking the pilgrimage to Mt. Sinai will travel to the southern tip of Israel, the city of Eilat. Here, we will spend three nights at our deluxe hotel on the shores of the Red Sea. Dinner and overnight at our deluxe hotel.

October 19, 2026- We rise to the beautiful sight of the sun glistening on the deep blue water of the Gulf of Aqaba.

THOSE NOT GOING TO PETRA will spend the day here relaxing in the sun, reflecting on the great week in Israel and having time to enjoy the new friends we have made on the trip. Those who are interested can snorkel or scuba, or spend the day shopping or visiting the world-famous underwater observatory in Eilat.

THOSE GOING TO PETRA will spend this day touring the city of Petra in Jordan, the capital of the Nabatean Kingdom at the time of Jesus and the Edomite Kingdom before it- - and recently declared to be one of the new "Seven Wonders of the World." You will marvel at the beauty and technology that these people demonstrated in carving this city out of solid pink rock. You will ride down the narrow entrance-way called the *Suq*, an experience you will never forget. At the end of this exciting day, we will return to our deluxe hotel in Eilat for dinner and overnight.

NOTE TO CLARIFY: The Petra Extension is an optional part of the Mt. Sinai Extension. Those who take the Mt. Sinai extension have the choice of going (or not going) to Petra. But to go to Petra, a person must also take the Mt. Sinai extension.

October 20, 2026 - We rise early and after breakfast set out for Mt. Sinai. We begin by visiting St. Catherine's Monastery at the base of Mt. Sinai, some 4000 feet above sea level. This monastery was first built by Helena, mother of Emperor Constantine in the 4th century AD. The monastery serves as the repository of some of the oldest mosaics, most exquisite icons and most precious manuscripts in all of Christendom. After visiting the monastery and having lunch, we will walk part way up Mt Sinai to get a beautiful panoramic view of the top of the mountain where God gave Moses The Ten Commandments, and at the valley below where the Israelites were camped for eleven months. Then we return for dinner and overnight at the deluxe hotel in Eilat.

October 21, 2026 - This morning, we rise leisurely and have time to savor all that we have experienced. Those who wish can snorkel in some of the best waters in the world. Others can simply relax by the pool. In the afternoon we fly to Tel Aviv for our return flight to the USA.

October 22, 2026 - Today we arrive in the USA early in the morning and connect with our homeward-bound flights, with fond memories of an unforgettable trip to the Holy Land.

TOUR APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT

1. Tour Agreement with Holyland Pilgrimage Tours ("HLP Tours,") Mevaseret Zion, Israel. Your tour agreement is with Holyland Pilgrimage Tours (HLP Tours) in Mevaseret Zion, Israel, and not with the tour host, guides or drivers. The terms set forth in this Tour Application and Agreement will become a binding contract when HLP Tours receives and accepts your signed application and deposit. Your submission of this Tour Application and payment of the deposit constitutes passenger acceptance of all terms, conditions, assumptions of risk, and releases from liability set forth in this Tour Application and Agreement.
2. Price. Tour price for Israel only portion, including coach airfare and two-people-per room accommodations, is \$3999 per person. Prices for extensions are: Sinai, \$950; Petra, \$399.
3. Deposit. The deposit, which must be submitted with this application, is \$750 per person.
4. Payment. Your deposit, payable to HLP Tours, must be submitted with this application.
5. Cancellation and Deposit Refund. If you cancel for any reason more than 135 days before the date of departure, the cancellation fee is \$750 per person (the entire deposit). If you cancel for any reason within 135 days of departure, the cancellation fee is 100% of the total tour price for each person. These cancellation fees are firm. **THUS, HLP TOURS URGES YOU TO OBTAIN TRAVEL INSURANCE.** Please Note: no funds applied to this tour from any previous HLP Tour will be refunded in cash or cash equivalents.
6. Tips. Your tips for guides, drivers, hotel personnel, etc. are not included in the price of the tour. You will be required to pay \$495 (Israel)/ \$275 (Sinai)/ & \$75 (Petra) per person for tips. This amount will be collected by HLP Tours with your final payment. HLP Tours will handle distribution of all tips during the tour.
7. Accommodations. Your accommodations will be in first-class hotels. Price is based on two persons in a room. HLP Tours will match up individual travelers with roommates. If this is impossible, the passenger must pay the single supplement.
8. Meals. Your meals will be breakfast and dinner throughout the program.
9. Guide. Your sightseeing includes an English-speaking guide and all entrance fees to sights listed in the program.
10. Items not included. Not included in the base price are (1) tips for guides, drivers, hotel and dining room staff, etc; (2) Israel arrival and departure taxes; (3) USA arrival and departure taxes; (4) El Al taxes and surcharges; (5) Israel hotel taxes and tourist taxes; (6) personal items such as laundry and drinks; (7) upgrade fee (\$200) to fly El Al; (8) excess baggage charges; (9) transfers other than with the group; and (10) visas and border taxes. At the time of publication of this brochure, all taxes and fees for the Israel portion of the tour total \$985 per passenger. If you go "Land Only," you will only pay the figure for the hotel taxes which total \$314. Any additional fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the published price of the tour has been released will be the sole responsibility of the passenger. Visa and border taxes for the Petra tour total \$225 per person, and for the Mt Sinai tour total \$225 per person.
11. Airline arrangements. Your airline arrangements will be finalized and your ticket written by HLP Tours a minimum of 150 days prior to departure. Once your ticket has been written, it cannot be re-written or refunded. Your flight times are subject to change without advance notice. HLP Tours is not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and does not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from delays (your travel insurance will normally cover these fees). If the airlines change flight schedules, HLP Tours reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. Occasionally, an increased cost may occur, which will be your responsibility. Please note: land only passengers who take the extension to Mount Sinai must pay \$125 extra for the flight EILAT-TLV on October 21, 2026.
12. Itinerary and Possible Changes to Itinerary. HLP Tours agrees to provide the itinerary described herein, subject to the following: HLP Tours reserves the right to alter the published itinerary in its sole discretion without advance notice and/or while the tour is in progress.
13. Possible Cancellation of Tour. HLP Tours reserves the right to withdraw, cancel or change the tour, in whole or in part, at any time, in its sole discretion. In the event of the tour being canceled for unforeseen circumstances, the cancellation and refund policy as stated herein shall apply.

14. Possible Revocation of Right to Travel Before or During. HLP Tours reserves the right to refuse or revoke travel to anyone who is determined to be, in the sole judgment of HLP Tours, incapable of group travel. If this determination is made while the tour is in progress, HLP Tours reserves the right to cancel all tour services and accommodations immediately and to send any passenger home early. In such cases, there will be no refund for any unused services.
15. Assumption of Risk in View of the Inherent Risks and Dangers International Travel. International travel involves certain inherent risks and dangers, including without limitation the following: (1) There is a risk of accident, serious injury and even death during travel by air, bus, boat or other means of conveyance, and at all other times during the tour; (2) There is a risk of negligence by private carriers used during the tour or their employees; (3) There is a risk of crime and theft; (4) There is a risk of violent attack by terrorists. Some or all of the destinations indicated in the itinerary may be covered by travel warnings or advisories issued by the U.S. State Department before or during the tour. Some of the specific destinations indicated on the itinerary may present more significant risk than others. HLP Tours and your tour host will endeavor to take reasonable precautions to avoid risks. However, there can be no guarantee that they will be successful in doing so. Accordingly, by signing this application, which will become a binding contract when accepted by HLP Tours, you are voluntarily and expressly agreeing to assume all such risks and hold HLP Tours and the tour host harmless for any injury or loss that may occur as a result of such risks, and to release them from any and all liability, claims or causes of action that may arise from the occurrence of such risks. HLP Tours and the tour host assume no liability whatsoever for actions by any person, or that result for any reason, outside the direct control of HLP Tours, including but not limited to events such as strikes, revolts, terrorist actions, civil unrest, wars, natural disasters, inclement weather, closures of airports or hotels, or the breach of contract, negligence or misconduct of any private carrier used during the tour. HLP Tours and the tour host are not responsible for any injury or loss that may occur while you are on board any airplane, bus, boat or other commercial carriers provided by HLP Tours under this Tour Agreement.
16. Release from Liability For Loss Or Injury Resulting From Ordinary Negligence. Except for the gross negligence or intentional wrongdoing of HLP Tours, its direct employees, or the tour host, HLP Tours assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, injury, inconvenience, illness, or damage of any kind (including general and consequential damages) occasioned by the ordinary negligence of such persons or by other circumstances and risks outside of their control.
17. Liquidated Damages For Breach Of Tour Agreement. In the event of a breach of contract by HLP Tours, HLP Tours will pay you as liquidated damages (not as a penalty) an amount equal to the total price you have paid for the tour. In no event will HLP Tours be liable for loss of profits or any special, incidental, or consequential damages, however caused, even if HLP Tours has been advised of the possibility of such damages. Any action arising under this Tour Agreement or because of its breach must be commenced within one year after the cause of action accrues. From the nature of the services to be provided by HLP Tours, it is impracticable and extremely difficult to fix the actual damages, if any, that you may incur as a result of HLP Tours's failure to perform any of its obligations under this Agreement. Accordingly, if HLP Tours is found liable for loss or damage arising from breach of this agreement, its liability will be limited to the refund to you of an amount equal to the total amount you paid for the tour as liquidated damages and not as a penalty, and this remedy shall be exclusive.
