MID-QUARTER REPORTS

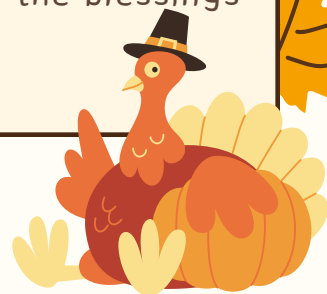
