


February Chapel Offerings

The offerings for the month of February will go to our Hearts for Jeus project, A New Children's Carepoint in Magoro, Uganda.




Roller Skating Party







Cookies for Grandparents Day


If your last name begins with A-L (grades K-5) please provide one dozen cookies for our guests on Grandparent's Day. You may send the cookies on Friday, March 6th.

Grandparents Day




Lenten Worship



The BOE & Finance Committee are still finalizing 2026-2027 Rates.






