NO SCHOOL

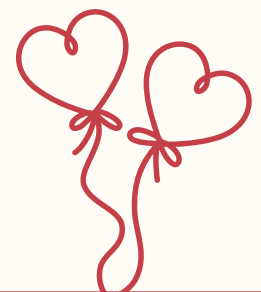
There will be no school on Friday, February 14th and Monday, February 17th for students in all grades, Pre-Kindergarten through 5th.
