

February Chapel Offerings


Parent Visit Day

Parents are always welcome at St. Paul's, but on February 5th and 6th our annual parent visitation days will be held.




Parent Teacher Conferences






Mercy Meals



Due to the weather we moved our day to pack Mercy Meals, the students will be helping pack meals Tuesday, February 17th in the Morning.
