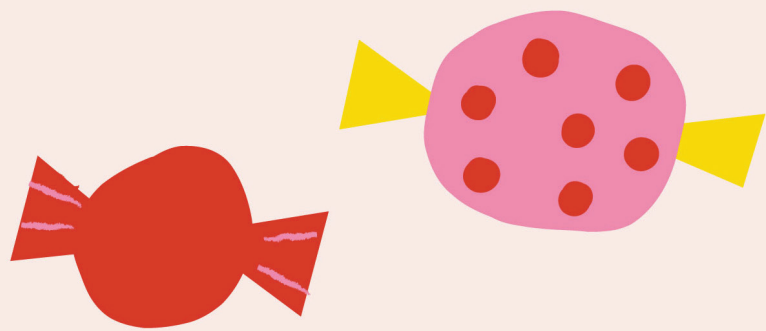

What You Need

- Fabric in a variety of textures
- Aluminum foil
- Fine grit sandpaper
- Bubble wrap
- Scissors
- Foam board
- Hot glue gun
- Satin ribbon
- Paper tags with string
- Plastic fillable heart-shaped ornament
- Permanent marker
- Towel or blanket

Feely Hearts

What You Do:

- Cut foam board in quarters.
- Cut fabric, aluminum foil, sandpaper, and bubble wrap into 4”-5” heart shapes, one heart per texture.
- Glue several hearts to each piece of foam board.
- Encourage children to explore the different textures.

What You Say:

“Touch the different hearts, this one is [soft] this one is [bumpy]. (Simply describe each texture as children touch it.) Look at all these hearts! Hearts mean love! [Child’s name], Jesus loves you so much and Jesus wants to your friend forever!”

This Big

What You Do:

- On each tag write child’s name and “Jesus loves me this big!”
- Measure each child’s wingspan with the ribbon and cut to length.
- Roll the ribbon and place it inside the heart shaped ornament.
- Attach the label, using the attached string to create the ornament hanger.
- Hold a child’s arms open wide while saying the phrase below.
- Put their arms down a little, and then do it again.

What You Say:

“Jesus loves you this biiiiiig. (Stretch child’s arms out wide. Then put them down.) Yes, He does! Jesus loves you this biiiiiig. (Stretch child’s arms out wide. Then put them down.) And Jesus wants to be your friend forever!”
