Talk About the Bible Story

Open the Bible together and read Luke 10:38-42 or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

Engagement Questions

- Who loves you?
- Where do you like to spend time with Jesus?



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say: "Good morning, [child's name]! I see someone Jesus loves ... YOU! And because Jesus loves you, He will always want to help you."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, sometimes being a grown-up is hard. Sometimes being a child is hard. Please help [child's name] and me remember that we can talk to Jesus anytime about anything and that Jesus will help us."



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your child to name their friends. Ask them what they like best about their friends. Talk about how Jesus loves us and wants to be our friend forever.



Bath Time

During bath time, take turns making a sound. (It can be anything.) The other person has to listen and guess what the sound is. Is it a frog? Train? Motorcycle? When you're done, talk about how Mary chose to spend time with Jesus and listen to Him.
