Pray for God to embrace the grieving, provide comfort, bring peace and offer strength — a profound way of offering support when words are inadequate

Pray for God to hear the specific needs (supplications) for ministries, whether it be for resources, wisdom or personnel, and that they would trust him to answer

Pray for our families, especially the children, who are a gift that has been lent from God—pray that the children may respect their parents and recognize the privilege they have in being part of a godly family unit; also ask that we behave in a manner pleasing to Him as heads of the household

Dear Lord, thank you that you know all things and you know everything about us. Thank you that we can cast all our cares upon you. Keep us from having anxious thoughts, and keep our minds stayed on you for we want to depend on you in all things, always.
