iv) Our role in sharing: Be a witness: Your testimony provides the evidence

General Excuse: I don't know how to answer their questions

You are not called to be an expert witness, judge, prosecutor or lawyer, you are called to be a witness: St John 9 vs 25: "Once I was blind now I see."

v) Point the person to the claims of Jesus: Son of God, 7 I am statements

Engaging in Evangelism Conversation:

Evangelism should be built around your love for Christ and humanity. It's about telling others about Christ under the guidance of the Holy Spirit and leaving the results to God.

St. John 4 vs 4-42: case study of Jesus and woman at the well.

1. Entry Phase (start): hook, bait, icebreakers, greetings, approach

2. Engagement Phase: Main message, purpose, theme, needs to address

3. Explore Phase: Further discussions, follow up invitations etc.

4. Exit Phase: Question or thoughts to ponder or invitation, making a decision.

The result is up to God and the move of the Holy Spirit.

4 vs 28-30: Samaritan woman: “come see a man.”

4 vs 42: The people of the town: “We no longer believe of what you said: now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world.”

If you find it difficult to share your faith, remember these four simple truths when sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ.
