### SERMON ACTS 4:32 - 5:11 "AUTHENTICITY WITH GOD AND WITH ONE ANOTHER" JIM WOMER

Our passage today describes a church transformed by God's grace and experiencing great unity and community. We are introduced to Joseph, better known by his nickname Barnabas ("Son of Encouragement"). We will look at the life of Barnabas over the course of several weeks. In today's passage, Barnabas is given as an example of a man who is authentic in community and in his worship. He is contrasted with Ananias and Sapphira, who wanted praise for their generosity, but lied to the Holy Spirit and faced a severe consequence. How can we be authentic in our church community? It begins with being authentic before God. It is with God's help that we can be authentic with one another.
