Title: "It is finished"

Text: John 19:30

Date: March 26, 2023

Introduction: Two thousand years ago on the border between heaven and hell, spikes were driven into the hands and feet of the Son of God. They were not of gold, but crude iron that tore the flesh. Right before He died, with a shout, Jesus said, "It is finished." This cry was the sixth word or saying that Christ spoke from the cross. I wonder what the people around Jesus thought when they heard Him say that?

- "It is finished," thought the beloved disciple John, "and I loved Him so much."
- "It is finished," thought Mary, His mother, "I can remember the night He was born."
- "It is finished," the disciples heard that cry and were discouraged, for they understood the cry to mean that Jesus had failed in His plan to redeem mankind.
- "It is finished," heard Pilate, "and I hope I never have to deal with another Messiah."
- "It is finished," thought the Centurion, "and what a marvelous man He must have been."
- "It is finished," thought the thief hanging beside Him who had accepted Him in faith, "and I will be with Him in paradise."
- "It is finished," the Pharisees were told and thought, "that will teach troublemakers not to interfere with us!"

When Jesus said "It is finished," He aroused a multitude of reactions in the individuals who heard it. Let's seek to understand what that statement actually meant. What do we need to comprehend?

I. It is a cry of relief.

II. It is a cry of accomplishment.

III. It is a cry of invitation.
