SOCIAL TIME

**The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.**

### Games and Music (10 minutes)

**What You Need:** Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Music and music player (optional)

#### What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

**Say:** That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

**Bible Story - Say This!**

Awesome! Thank you, Super Crew and Bark! I knew you could help us. Moses was a great leader, and God used him to help the people of Israel. Can you believe they walked around in the wilderness for 40 years? That is a long time! But God was faithful to give them everything they needed. God is faithful means that God can be trusted, and He will always do what He says He will do. Sometimes the people turned away from God and sinned. Sins are the wrong choices we make. But Moses reminded the people of God's promise to be faithful. Moses even wrote a song to remind the people of God's faithfulness. When the Earth turns we have day and night. We can trust that the Earth is turning, and we can trust that God is faithful and will always love us.

*Let's talk and listen to God. This is called prayer. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1.*

*God, thank You for loving us so much. Thank You that Your love is faithful. We can trust You and know that You will do what You say You will do. In Jesus' name, amen.*

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

*L-O-V-E! (Cross arms over chest and rotate your body for every letter.)*

*God Loves Me! (Point up with open palms to the sky. Bring hands to chest.)*

**Bible Story Video (10 minutes)****Beautiful Earth- Craft (20 minutes)**

**Big Goal:** Connect with the Super Clue.

**Leader Prep:** Print "Beautiful Earth" printables on cardstock, one per child. Cut blue and green tissue paper into small squares. Make a sample.

**Supplies:** "Beautiful Earth" printables on cardstock (1 per child), Glue sticks (1 per child), Adult scissors (1 per group), Blue and green tissue paper (several), "Beautiful Earth Instructions & Example" printable (1 per group; optional)

**Craft Instructions:**

1. Before the session, print "Beautiful Earth" printables on cardstock, one per child. Cut blue and green tissue paper into small squares. Make a sample.
2. Give each preschooler a "Beautiful Earth" picture, a glue stick, and green and blue tissue paper squares.
3. Demonstrate how to make land by gluing green tissue paper down and water by gluing blue tissue paper down.
4. Invite preschoolers to decorate their pictures with blue and green tissue paper. Assist with glue as needed.

**What To Do:** Does anyone remember what today's Super Clue is? (*Allow responses.*) Yes! It is the Earth. Earth is the planet where we live. It is covered with land and water. God created Earth a long, long, long time ago. Let's make our own picture of the Earth. We are going to decorate the Earth with blue and green tissue paper. What color tissue paper do you think we will use to make the water? (*Allow responses.*) Yes! We will use blue. And what color will we use for the land? (*Allow responses.*) You are correct. We will use green.

I am going to give everyone a "Beautiful Earth" sheet. Then we are going to use glue sticks to cover the space that is water. Carefully add blue tissue paper to the glue for water. Once we are finished with the water, we can add glue to the land and press green tissue paper on our papers. Continue working on your picture until you are finished.

**Leader Tip:** Remind preschoolers that glue only goes on the paper, not clothing or hands.

**Loud And Clear:** Everyone did an amazing job! The words on our paper say **God's love is faithful**. Just like we know that the Earth is going to turn and every day we are going to have day and night, we can also know that God loves us. **God's love is faithful** and can be trusted. God will always do what He says He will do.

**Say:**

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*the Earth*)
- What does the Earth help us remember about God's love? (*Just like we can trust the Earth to keep turning every day, we can trust that God's love is faithful.*)
- What did Moses tell the people about God? (*Moses told the people about the wonderful things God had done when He rescued them from Egypt. He reminded them of the ways God had been with them and taken care of them.*)
- **God's love is faithful.** What does it mean that **God's love is faithful?** (*God can always be trusted, and He does what He says He will do.*)
- What did you learn about God today?
- Do you remember today's Big Deal? Repeat after me (*with motions below*): L-O-V-E! (*L-O-V-E!*) God Loves Me! (*God Loves Me!*)

**Keep It Going:** Form two groups of preschoolers. Assign one group "L-O-V-E!" and the other group "God Loves Me." When you point to each group, encourage them to say their part of the Big Deal.

**Big Deal Motions:**

L-O-V-E! (*Cross arms over chest and rotate your body for every letter.*)

God Loves Me! (*Point up with open palms to the sky. Bring hands to chest.*)

Today was a great day to be at church and learn about God's promises. In our Bible story we learned that God's people made wrong choices. This is called *sin*. We make wrong choices, too, but God loves us and will forgive us when we ask Him.

**Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.**

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
