SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have Animal Action Dice and Heart Seek and Find.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. **Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Painter's tape, Paul's Letter (2 per group per service)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

That was great! Thank you, Super Crew! Today we learned that God's love never ends. Paul told the Christians in Corinth what is true about Jesus. He reminded them that God's promises never end, and one day Jesus will come back again. Jesus came so people could have a friendship with God because He loves us. When God makes a promise, we can always trust Him. God keeps His promises.

Today's Super Clue is a candy ring. The part that goes on our finger is a circle. Remember, a circle never ends. This is like God's love—it never ends! He loves you and me forever and ever.

Let's talk and listen to God. This is called prayer. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1.

God, thank You so much for loving us and that Your love never ends. Help us tell our friends about Your amazing love. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

L-O-V-E! (Cross arms over chest and rotate your body for every letter.)

God Loves Me! (Point up with open palms to the sky. Bring hands to chest.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

Never Ending- Craft (20 minutes)

Big Goal: Learn the Main Idea: **God's love never ends.**

Leader Prep: Print the "Never-Ending" printable on cardstock, one wristband per child. Cut the wristbands apart.

Supplies: "Never-Ending" printable on cardstock cut apart (1 per child), Adult scissors (1 per group), Markers and crayons (several), Heart stamps, Tape (several), "Never-Ending Instructions & Example" printable (1 per group; optional)

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, print the "Never-Ending" printable on cardstock, one wristband per child. Cut the wristbands apart.
2. Give each preschooler markers and crayons, heart stamps and a "Never-Ending" rectangle.
3. Invite preschoolers to color and decorate their wristbands.
4. Once preschoolers have finished decorating, assist them in wrapping the wristband around their wrist, taping it, and trimming the excess paper.

What To Do: A circle is such a neat shape. Let's say, "Circle," together. Ready? "Circle." Good! Let's look around the room and see if we can find any circles. (Allow preschoolers to point out the circles they see in the room.) Great job finding circles. Let's form a circle with our hands. Hold your hands in the air and form a circle with your fingers. (Allow time for preschoolers to make circles.) You did wonderful! When we see a circle, we do not know where the circle starts and ends. The circle goes on and on without stopping. Today we are going to make a circle wristband that we can wear. Each of you will get a wristband that says **God's love never ends.** You will get markers and crayons to color your wristband, and when you finish decorating it, a leader will come around and help you put the wristband around your wrist, tape it, and then trim off any extra paper.

Keep It Going: Allow preschoolers to make an extra wristband to share with a friend.

Loud And Clear: I loved watching you make your crafts. You did great, and I love that your wristbands are all different. These circles remind us of how **God's love never ends.** Just like your wristband never ends because it is shaped like a circle, **God's love never ends** too. Let's praise God with a big clap because of how big His love is. (Invite preschoolers to clap.) Good! Now let's say, "**God's love never ends,**" together. Ready? "**God's love never ends!**" Way to go!

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*a candy ring*)
- What does a candy ring help us remember? (*Like a circle never ends, God's love never ends.*)
- How can you show your friends and family God's love this week? (*Help them, be kind to them by letting them go first or choose what to play, make them a special picture, spend time with them, and so on.*)
- **God's love never ends.** What book tells us about how **God's love never ends?** (*the Bible*) What are other things you know that the Bible tells us about?
- What did you learn about God today?
- Who can you tell about God's never-ending love.
- Do you remember today's Big Deal? Repeat after me (*with motions below*): L-O-V-E! (*L-O-V-E!*) God Loves Me! (*God Loves Me!*)

Keep It Going: Practice saying the Big Deal in different voices. Say the Big Deal in a whisper voice, a robot voice, a deep voice, and a high-pitched voice.

Big Deal Motions:

L-O-V-E! (*Cross arms over chest and rotate your body for every letter.*)
God Loves Me! (*Point up with open palms to the sky. Bring hands to chest.*)

Paul went to the city of Corinth to tell the people true things about God. One thing that is true about God is that His love never ends! Let's say that together. Ready? **"God's love never ends!"** Way to go!

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
