SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have Hot Potato and Memory Game or Scavenger Hunt.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. **Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, microphone (1 per group), Music and music player (1 per group)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Bye, Super Crew! See you next time! In our Bible story, David made a wrong choice, and Nathan helped David see that he was making a wrong choice. David was sorry for his wrong choices and wrote a prayer asking God to forgive him. God knew David's actions and knew he made a wrong choice. God knows our actions too. God knows when we make wrong choices, and He is ready to forgive us. When we make a wrong choice, we can press pause, stop what we are doing, and ask God to forgive us. And He always does!

Great job! Let's pray and thank God for helping us obey Him. When we pray, we talk and listen to God.

God, thank You so much for always being ready to forgive us when we make a wrong choice. Help us make right choices and obey You. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Press Pause! (Hold both hands out with palms out.)

God Cares When I Hurt! (Give yourself a hug.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Light Switch Headband(20 minutes)**

Preschoolers will decorate light switch headbands.

Big Goal: Remember the Super Clue and the Main Idea, "God Knows My Actions."

Supplies: "Light Switch Headband" printable (1 per child), Cardstock (several), Scissors (1 per group; adult-use only), Tape (1 per group), Markers or crayons (several), Stapler (1 per group; optional)

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, print "Light Switch Headband" printables on cardstock, one per child. Cut out the light switches and headband strips.
2. Distribute a light switch, headband strips, and crayons or markers to each child.
3. Invite preschoolers to color their light switches and headband strips.
4. Tape or staple light switches to the headband strips.
5. Fit the headband strips around each preschooler's head and connect with tape or staples.

What To Do: Let's make a craft to help us remember today's Main Idea. Today's Main Idea is, "God Knows My Actions." Let's say that together. "God knows my actions." Great! Who remembers what today's Super Clue is? (Allow responses.) That's right! It's a light switch. It's a what? (A light switch!) Each of you has a few strips of paper, a light switch, and crayons to share. You are going to color the light switch and the strips of paper. Once you are done coloring, a leader will help you tape or staple the light switch on the headband strip. Then a leader will help fit the headband to your head and tape or staple it together. This is going to be so much fun! I can't wait to see you in your headbands.

Loud And Clear: Great job with your headbands! They look fantastic! Our headbands have our Super Clue on them. Our Super Clue is a light switch. A light switch helps us turn on a light, and the light helps us see the actions of everyone in the room. God sees all of our actions—even our wrong choices. A light switch reminds us that God sees our actions, loves us no matter what, and wants to help us obey and follow Him.

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*a light switch*)
- Today's Super Clue is a light switch. What does a light switch help us remember? (*A light switch helps us turn on a light, and the light helps us see the actions of everyone in the room. God sees all of our actions—even our wrong choices.*)
- Who did God send to tell David he made a wrong choice? (*the prophet Nathan*)
- What can we do when our actions are wrong? (*Press pause and ask God for forgiveness.*)
- What did you learn about God today?

Our Big Deal is, Press Pause! God cares when I hurt!

Press Pause! (*Hold both hands out with palms out.*)

God Cares When I Hurt! (*Give yourself a hug.*)

God knows when we make wrong choices, and He is ready to forgive us. When we make a wrong choice, we can press pause, stop what we are doing, and ask God to forgive us. And He always does!

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
