SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have Hot Potato and Memory Game or Scavenger Hunt.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. **Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, microphone (1 per group), Music and music player (1 per group)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Thanks, Super Crew and Bark! In our Bible story today, God knew what Moses was thinking, that he was worried and did not believe in God's plan or power. Today's Super Clue is a pause button. When we press a pause button, whatever we are watching or listening to pauses or stops. When we see a pause button, we can remember that we can pause too. We can pause when we think wrong or unkind thoughts and ask God for help. God cares for us, and He wants to help us.

Great job! Let's pray and thank God for helping us obey Him. When we pray, we talk and listen to God.

God, thank You for loving and caring for us, even when we think wrong thoughts. Help us remember that we can always press pause and ask You for help. You are with us every day. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Press Pause! (Hold both hands out with palms out.)

God Cares When I Hurt! (Give yourself a hug.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Bible Story Reminders(20 minutes)**

Big Goal: Remember the Bible story and the Simple Truth, "God Cares When I Hurt."

Supplies: "Bible Story Reminders" printable (1 per child), Cardstock (1 per child), Large craft sticks (1 per child), Glue sticks (1 per child), Crayons (several), Scissors (1 per group; adult-use only), Tape (1 per group)

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, print and cut apart "Bible Story Reminders" printables, one set per child.
2. Give each preschooler the "Bible Story Reminders" images, crayons, a craft stick, and a glue stick.
3. Invite preschoolers to color the pictures.
4. Assist preschoolers in taping a craft stick to the back of one of the pictures. Then help them glue the papers back to back with the craft stick in the middle.

What To Do: We are going to make a craft to help us remember today's Bible story. Each of you will get two pictures from our Bible story. First, I want you to color the pictures. Leaders will come around and help you tape a craft stick to the back of one picture and then glue the papers together back to back.

Keep It Going: Use the Bible story images to help preschoolers retell the story.

Loud And Clear: Does anyone remember who was in our Bible story? (**Allow responses.**) That is right! Moses and God were in our Bible story today. Our Bible story pictures show us two different parts of the story. First, we have the part where Moses had doubts about God's power and God's plan. We also have a picture showing where Moses obeyed God. Just like Moses, when we have wrong thoughts, we can pause and ask God for help. God will help us because He cares for us when we hurt.

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*a pause button*)
- What does a pause button help us remember? (*When we think wrong thoughts, we can press pause and ask God for help.*)
- What was your favorite part of today's story?
- How does God care for us today? (*God knows what we think. When we think wrong thoughts, we can pause and ask God for help. We can remember that God loves us and cares for us no matter what. God can help take away our wrong thoughts.*)
- What did you learn about God today?

Our Big Deal is, Press Pause! God cares when I hurt!
Press Pause! (*Hold both hands out with palms out.*)
God Cares When I Hurt! (*Give yourself a hug.*)

Today we are learning that God knows what we think. Even when we have wrong thoughts, like when we doubt God's plan is good, God still loves us and cares for us.

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
