SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have puzzles and interlocking building sets.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. ***Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.*

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Cardstock or carpet markers (several; assorted colors), Painter's tape (1 per group)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

In our Bible story today, we learned about how God provided skilled and talented workers to build His tabernacle. A tabernacle is a special place to praise and worship God. The skilled workers obeyed God and used their talents to make the tabernacle and bring praise to God. Remember, talented means that God made each one of us really good at different things. God made you special. Today's Super Clue is instruments. It takes talent and skill to play an instrument. God gives us talents and skills to do amazing things. Some of us can draw, some of us can play instruments, some of us can sing, some of us can make people laugh, and so much more.

Great job! Let's pray and thank God for helping us obey Him. When we pray, we talk and listen to God.

God, we are so thankful for You. Thank You for making each of us special with talents that we can use to celebrate and praise You. We love You. In Jesus' name, amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Oh Wow! (Cross arms in front of face with palms facing out. Uncross arms, and lean forward.)

God Made Me Special! (Put hands up facing inward. Bring fists to hips, and strike a superhero pose.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Sticky Note Picture—**

Preschoolers will work together to create a picture using sticky notes.

Supplies: Colored sticky notes (1 per child), Large Sheets of Paper (several per group)

SAY: Hello, friends! I am so glad you are here today. Leaders are walking around the room now to give each of you a colored sticky note. You might already notice that your neighbor has a different color than you. That is okay! After everyone receives a sticky note, we are going to form groups based on the color of the sticky note you received. This will be your team. Your team will work together to create a picture using all of the sticky notes in your group on the large sheet of paper. You might make a sun or a tree or something really crazy like a monster! If you need extra sticky notes, a leader will be able to give you a few more. I'm going to point to a corner of the room and assign a spot for each color. When you hear your color called, I want you to move quickly to your part of the room and begin working with your team to create a picture. *(Point to sections of the room and assign a color for each spot.)* I can't wait to see what your team creates!

Leader Tip: Assign a leader to each color team to help facilitate ideas and encourage preschoolers. Extend the activity by having "show and tell". Give groups a chance to explain their picture to the group.

Connect It: Now, we are going to create a tabernacle together with my sticky notes. Everyone join me here. We will take turns building with sticky notes. *(As you build talk about the Bible story and how God used people to create the tabernacle so God could be close to the people. Remind them that Jesus came so we don't need a building to be close to God.)* You worked together as a team to create beautiful pieces of artwork. We sometimes make pictures using crayons or markers, but this was a special and different type of art we made using sticky notes. God made you special too! I am glad we can learn more about God together.

TALK IT OUT

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*instruments*)
- What do instruments help us remember? (*When we hear the special sound an instrument makes, we can remember that we have our own gifts and talents that we can use to celebrate God.*)
- How did God's people use their talents and skills? What did they build? (*They built the tabernacle, the place where God would dwell.*)
- **God made me talented.** What are some of your talents that you can use to celebrate God?
- What did you learn about God today?

Our Big Deal is, Oh WOW! God Made Me Special!

Oh Wow! (*Cross arms in front of face with palms facing out. Uncross arms, and lean forward.*)

God Made Me Special! (*Put hands up facing inward. Bring fists to hips, and strike a superhero pose.*)

The tabernacle reminds us that God's people obeyed Him and used their talents to worship and celebrate Him. God gives talents to each person that can be used to celebrate and praise Him. We can use our talents and skills to celebrate God too! God made us special, and we can celebrate Him!

GOING HOME

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
