SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have puzzles and interlocking building sets.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. **Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

In today's Bible story we learned that God made us, and He knows every little thing about us. We are important to God, and He wants a friendship with us. Our Super Clue, fingerprints, can help us remember that God made each of us special and that God says we matter. Point to yourself and say, "God says I matter!" Ready? (God says I matter!) Great!

Great job! Let's pray and thank God for helping us obey Him. When we pray, we talk and listen to God.

God, thank You for the Bible that helps us know that You say we matter. Thank You for making each of us special and for our fingerprints that remind us that You say we matter. We love you. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Oh Wow! (Cross arms in front of face with palms facing out. Uncross arms, and lean forward.)

God Made Me Special! (Put hands up facing inward. Bring fists to hips, and strike a superhero pose.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Fingerprint Celebration—**

Preschoolers will decorate a celebration pennant using their fingerprints.

Supplies: "Fingerprint Celebration" printable (1 per child), Cardstock (several), Washable ink pads (several), Baby wipes (several), Crayons (several; optional), crazy straw (1 per child), Washi Tape (several per group)

Craft Instructions:

1. Give each preschooler a pennant and a crazy straw.
2. Invite preschoolers to press their fingertips in the ink pads and then press them onto their pennants to create a fingerprint. Encourage them to add as many fingerprints as they would like.
3. Give each preschooler a baby wipe to clean their fingers.
4. Allow preschoolers to color their pennants if desired.
5. Assist preschoolers in taping a crazy straw to the back of the pennant to make a handle.

SAY: Our Super Clue today is fingerprints. Your fingerprints are one of a kind—they don't match anyone else! God made your fingerprints special just for you. We are going to use our fingerprints to make a special pennant we can use to celebrate that God says we matter. You can take your finger and press it on the ink pad, then press it onto the pennant to decorate it. When you finish adding your fingerprints, you can use a baby wipe to clean your fingers. You can use your favorite colors to continue decorating your pennants. When you are finished, we will tape a crazy straw to the back to give your pennant a handle. (Talk with preschoolers about how even though everyone made the same picture, they are all different and special because no one has the same fingerprints.)

Loud And Clear: Oh wow! The pennants you made are so special. Your fingerprints don't match anyone else! God made your fingerprints special just for you. Your pennants can remind you that God made you special. God knows everything about you. **God says you matter!**

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*fingerprints*)
- What do fingerprints help us remember? (*God made me special. There is no one exactly like me.*)
- What was your favorite part of the Bible story?
- **God says you matter.** How can you know you matter to God? (*God knows everything about me, and He says I matter.*)
- What did you learn about God today?
- What have you learned that you can share with your family or friends this week?

Our Big Deal is, Oh WOW! God Made Me Special!

Oh Wow! (*Cross arms in front of face with palms facing out. Uncross arms, and lean forward.*)

God Made Me Special! (*Put hands up facing inward. Bring fists to hips, and strike a superhero pose.*)

God made all of our fingerprints different from each other. God says you matter, you are special to Him, and He made you like no one else. God knows every detail about you because you matter to Him.

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
