SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have puzzles and interlocking building sets.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. ***Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.*

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Dry erase board or large note pad (1 per group), Dry erase markers (several), Dry eraser (1 per group), Red, green, yellow, and blue construction paper (4 per group); Painter's tape (1 per group)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

In today's Bible story, God had a special plan for Jeremiah before he was born. God wanted Jeremiah to give God's people important messages. Jeremiah was special to God, and God had a plan for his life. You are special to God too. He has a plan for your life.

Our Super Clue today is play dough. When we open a container of play dough, we already have something in mind that we want to create or make. God made each of us special. Today we are learning that God made me on purpose. Let's say that together. "God made me on purpose."

Great job! Let's pray and thank God for helping us obey Him. When we pray, we talk and listen to God.

God, we are so thankful You made each of us. Thank You for the plans and purposes You have for each preschooler here. Help us remember that You made us on purpose, and You have special plans for us. Help us love You more this week and show Your love to others. In Jesus' name, amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Oh Wow! (Cross arms in front of face with palms facing out. Uncross arms, and lean forward.)

God Made Me Special! (Put hands up facing inward. Bring fists to hips, and strike a superhero pose.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Creative Designing –**

Preschoolers will use various art supplies to create their own unique artwork.

Leader Prep: Place a variety of art supplies out for preschoolers to use. Cut yarn pieces in various lengths.

Supplies: Markers or crayons (several), Chenille stems (several), Glue sticks (several), Construction paper (several), Tape (1 per group), Pom-poms (several), Yarn (several), Stickers (several), Scissors (1 per group; adult-use only)

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, cut several yarn pieces in various lengths.
2. Invite preschoolers to make their own creations using available craft supplies. Encourage them to use their creativity and imaginations as they create their art.

SAY: Today's craft time is going to be so exciting! You get to use your imagination to make a craft. In our Bible story today, God spoke to a man named Jeremiah and told him he had been made for a very special purpose. You are going to create your own special artwork today. There are all kinds of art supplies available for you to use. I want you to think of something to create with what we've provided. Plan your creation in your mind, and get busy creating! You can make things like a dog, a cat, a house, a fish, or a swimming pool.

Keep It Going: Allow preschoolers an opportunity to share what they created with the group. Walk around the room, and ask preschoolers what they are creating. Ask questions about their plans and design. Be sure to listen attentively!

Loud And Clear: When I asked you to make something fun and exciting with these supplies, I imagine you already had a plan in your head about what you were going to make. You had a plan and a purpose for your art creation. We learned in the Bible that God made each of us on purpose. In our Bible story today, we learned that God made us on purpose. He made Jeremiah to tell important messages to God's people. God has a special plan for *our* lives too. We are made on purpose by God, and He has special plans for us.

TALK IT OUT

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*play dough*)
- What does play dough help us remember? (*God made each of us on purpose. We are special, and He has a plan for us.*)
- In our Bible story today, God told a man that He wanted him to go tell important messages to His people. What was the man's name? (*Jeremiah*)
- Today we learned that **God made me on purpose**. What does it mean that God made you on purpose? (*God has a special plan for my life.*)
- What did you learn about God today?

Our Big Deal is, Oh WOW! God Made Me Special!

Oh Wow! (*Cross arms in front of face with palms facing out. Uncross arms, and lean forward.*)

God Made Me Special! (*Put hands up facing inward. Bring fists to hips, and strike a superhero pose.*)

Our Bible Story reminds us that God made us special and with great purpose. Just like we mold a piece of play dough into a special creation, God molds us to do great things for Him. We are God's wonderful creation!

GOING HOME

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
