The first 10 minutes as kids arrive is a very important time in your small group. Because of this, we provide you with intentional activities to engage their interests and help lead into a great discussion. All of this is so that "boredom" is not an excuse. Everything is only available one time.

Every week you have:

- Roku Games to play together that are changed out monthly.
- 2 month specific games or group activities.
- Plus 2 Social Activities. ** Use one now and save the other for an incentive to participate in all the activities.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Instruction Page, Game Sets, Roku Game Instruction Page, Corner Numbers 1-4, painter's tape, "Puzzle Verse" printable (1 per group- cut apart in puzzle type pieces), Paper (1 per team), Scissors (1 per group; adult-use only), Marker (1 per group), Dry erase board and marker (1 per group), Stopwatch or timer (1 per group)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

SOCIAL TIME

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Bible Story Recap- Say This**

Our world does not always look at and value talents the same. We may celebrate or admire people who are really good at sports, or amazing singers, or who invent cool things. But we may not always notice or celebrate other talents. People are not always good judges of talent, but God is! Every talent that God gives you is good and valuable because God designed it that way. The reason God gave us talents is to accomplish His very important purpose for us—to know God and point others to Him. Say, “God made me talented!” (God made me talented!)

God worked through Bezalel (BEHZ uh lehl) and Oholiab (oh HOH lih ab) for a very specific purpose—to help build the tabernacle. God chose these special, talented workers to help make the place where He would spend time with His people and teach His people about His love for them. God called Bezalel and Oholiab by name and knew every detail about them—their talents, their abilities, and more—because He made them. What God makes is always special and valuable to Him.

Gospel Connection: (refer to the 4 Circles poster in your small group spaces)

(Circle three) God made you and values you so much that He sent His only Son, Jesus, for you. Point to yourself, and say, “God sent Jesus for me!”

(Circle two) God knows everything about you, even you sin—the wrong things you think, do, or say that go against God’s best plan for you. The Bible says we all sin, and because of sin, we have a broken relationship with God. We also have a broken view of ourselves. We do not always trust and believe that God made us unique and talented. We might even try and use our talents in different ways than God made us to use them, like trying to bring attention to ourselves instead of God. We all have a sin problem because of our brokenness that we can’t fix on our own.

(Circle three) But that is not where the story ends. God loves us so much; He believes that what He made is valuable enough to rescue. God sent His Son, Jesus, for you and me. Jesus never sinned. He is perfect and holy, so He is the only one who could fix our sin problem. Jesus died on a cross, taking the punishment our sin deserved. However, Jesus didn’t stay dead. He rose again and is alive today! Because of Jesus and His sacrifice for us, we can have forgiveness and receive a new relationship with God when we respond to this truth by believing and trusting in Jesus.

(Circle four) When we have a relationship with God through Jesus, we can use our talents the way God made them to be used.

(Circle one) God created the world, and He made people to know Him, follow Him, and use the talents He gave them for His purposes and plans. God gets excited when we use the gifts He has given us for His purpose—to know Him more and share His love with others!

Talk to a leader if you want to know more about following Jesus!

God made you, piece by piece! God uniquely designed every part of you, including your talents and what makes you special. You can always know that you specially and wonderfully made by our amazing God who loves you so much.

God, thank You for designing each of us piece by piece. You made us, and You love us. You have given us amazing talents so we can honor You and point others to You. Help us to see and appreciate our own talents and the talents You have given others. Amen.

Hidden Talent

Big Goal: Know that God made us and others talented.

Supplies: Toothpick Star Science Experiment (1 per kid), 5 round toothpicks (per kid), plate (1 per kid), water, droppers or syringes (1 per kid)

What To Do: Set up the science experiment and demonstrate it for the whole group. Then pass out supplies for kids to try it on their own.

Say, Our Bible story today showed us the story of Oholiab (oh HOH lih ab) and Bezalel (BEHZ uh lehl)! God made those two men with specific talents for His specific purpose—to build the tabernacle, the portable tent where God met with His people. God uniquely designed them for that very purpose! God has also designed you. He may not have made you a craftsman like Bezalel and Oholiab, but He designed you with other talents to share His love with others. Always remember that God uniquely designed you.

When we look at science experiments or other skills that show the complexity around us, we can be reminded that God created each of us and gave us all talents and abilities that are meant to help us know God better and share what we know about Him with others.

You can take the pieces to this experiment home to show your family you new talent. You can make a star out of broken pieces of a toothpick.

Loud And Clear: Congratulations on finding the hidden talent! Like in our experiment, sometimes it might feel hard seeing and knowing what talents we have. However, we can know we have talents because God made us talented. Say, “God made me talented!” (*God made me talented!*) He crafted you with unique gifts. Whenever you have trouble remembering how special and talented you are, remember that God uniquely designed you.

Let’s chat about this more by looking at some questions that make us think deeper.

TALK ABOUT IT

Discussion Questions:

- Have you ever built something? Maybe you built a toy creation or made the most incredible sandcastle! What did you make, and how did you feel about what you made when you finished? (Allow answers, and share your own answer.)
- The Bible tells us God uniquely designed us with gifts and talents. Let's open our Bibles to **Exodus 31:2-3** and read about it together. (Invite kids to open their Bibles. Read the passage aloud, or invite a kid who volunteers to read the passage aloud. Be sure to have Bibles available for kids who need one. Help kids find the passage so everyone can follow along together.) God made Bezalel (BEHZ uh lehl) and Oholiab (oh HOH lih ab) with special and unique talents. How can knowing God gave us our talents change the way we think about using them? (Allow answers, and share your own answers.)
- God gave each of us talents. When we trust in Jesus and follow Him, we can use those talents to point others to God. How can you use your talents to point others to Him? (Allow kids to answer, and share your own answer.) God sent His Son, Jesus, because He loves you and wants to have a forever relationship with you! God made you talented, and you can use your talents to honor and follow Him while pointing others Him.
- Sometimes we admire how talented someone else is and wonder, *Am I special like that?* We may not have the same talents as others, but we are all talented because God made us talented! How could today's Bible story and what we have learned help you or a friend who is wondering about being talented? (Allow answers, and share your own answers.)

WRAP UP

The Bible tells us God designed us with unique talents and gifts. He designed you—talents and all—piece by piece! What is something encouraging you will remember from today? Is there anything you have questions about? (Allow kids to answer, and share your own answer.) Let's talk to God by praying. (Lead the group in prayer.

Consider using the following prayer prompt.)

God, thank You for giving us special gifts and talents. Thank You for taking the time to make us piece by piece. You uniquely designed each of us. Help us use our talents to point other to You. Thank You for loving us so much! Amen.

God uniquely designed each of you, creating you piece by piece! He gave you specific gifts and talents. You are valuable because God made you and designed you to be exactly who you are! No matter what, you can know you were designed by God. Say it after me, "I am uniquely designed." (I am uniquely designed.) **"God made me talented!" (God made me talented!)**

GOING HOME

Pass out the coloring pages for kids to take home. Greet families as they arrive and tell them something about their child you saw today. Say goodbye and call everyone by name.
