### I Am Loved Leader Weekly Devotion

**Bible Passage:** Jesus died and came back to life- Matthew 27-28

**Bottom Line:** Jesus is Alive

**Leader Context:** As we celebrate Easter through the story of Jesus' death and resurrection, we get to share the good news of the gospel and make room for conversations where kids can ask questions and make decisions to trust and follow Jesus.

**THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS:** Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

**Read-** Matthew 27:32- 28:8

**Highlight:** Matthew 28:5-6

As we celebrate Easter through the story of Jesus' death and resurrection, we get to share the good news of the gospel and make room for conversations where kids can ask questions and make decisions to trust and follow Jesus.

**Reflect-** How can you celebrate the resurrection of Jesus this week?

- Read over the Easter story during the next couple of days: Matthew 28; Mark 16; Luke 24; John 20.
- Invite a friend or neighbor to join you for church on Easter.
- Share with someone that Jesus is alive and how it has changed your life.

**Pray:** Thank You for sending Your Son, Jesus, to die on the cross in my place. And thank You that Jesus is alive! May my love for You and awe of Your sacrifice overflow into conversations with those around me. Amen.

**Prepare:** What has God taught you throughout this Easter season and who can you share it with?
