SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have Wiggle and Giggle Game cards and Suction Toys.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. ***Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.*

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Beanbag (1 per group), Music/Theme Song

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Thanks, Super Crew! In today's Bible story, God spoke to Isaiah in a vision while he was awake. God wanted Isaiah to know Him, and God showed Isaiah that He is holy and different from everything. Let's say, "God is holy," together. Ready? "God is holy." Good job! What is today's Super Clue? (*A crown!*) Yes! Our Super Clue is a crown! When you wear a crown, it shows that you are special. God is very special and set apart. He is not like anyone else. God is holy, and He is the King of everything! Even though God is holy, we can know Him!

Let's talk and listen to God. This is called prayer. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1.

God, You are holy. Thank You for sending Jesus, Your Son, so we can know You, the King of everything! Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Ready, Set, Grow! (*Spread hands in front of body making a circle with palms facing out.*)

God Wants Me to Know Him! (*Push hands up to the sky with palms facing each other.*)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Special Delivery- Craft (20 minutes)**

Preschoolers will decorate a letter to give to a friend.

Big Goal: Remember the Bible story.

Supplies: "Special Delivery" printable (1 per child), Envelopes (1 per child), Stickers (several), Markers or crayons (several), "Special Delivery Craft Instructions and Example"

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, print "Special Delivery" printables, one per child.
2. Give each preschooler a "Special Delivery" printable and markers or crayons.
3. Encourage preschoolers to decorate their letters.
4. Assist preschoolers in folding their letters, putting them in envelopes, and sealing them with a sticker.
5. Help them write the name of the person they will deliver their special message to on the envelope.

What To Do: In today's Bible story, God gave a man named Isaiah a special message in a vision. What was the man's name? (*Isaiah!*) Great! In the vision, God showed Isaiah that He is holy and different than anything else. We are going to decorate a letter with an important truth about God and seal it in an envelope.

After you finish, think about someone you want to deliver your letter to when you leave. I will help you write the name of the person on the front of your envelope.

Leader Tip: Guide preschoolers to share why they chose the person they did to give their special delivery.

Loud And Clear: These letters are going to make a very special delivery! In our Bible story today, we learned that God wanted Isaiah to know Him. God showed Isaiah that He is special and set apart. He is the King of everything, and He is holy! God is different from everyone because all people sin and make wrong choices, but God never makes wrong choices.

Say:

1. Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? *(a crown)*
2. What does a crown help us remember? *(When you wear a crown, it shows you are special. God is very special and set apart. God is the King of everything.)*
3. What is something you liked about Large Group?
4. **God is holy.** What does it mean that **God is holy**? *(God is different from everyone else because all people sin and make wrong choices, but God never makes wrong choices.)*
5. What did you learn about God today?

Keep It Going: Form two teams of preschoolers. Invite the two teams to take turns leading the others in the Big Deal using the motions below.

Big Deal Motions:

Ready, Set, Grow! *(Spread hands in front of body making a circle with palms facing out.)*

God Wants Me to Know Him! *(Push hands up to the sky with palms facing each other.)*

We have had such a fun time together learning that God wants us to know Him. One thing we can know about God is that He is holy. This reminds me of our Big Deal, "Ready, Set, Grow! God Wants Me to Know Him!" Let's say that together. "Ready, Set, Grow! God Wants Me to Know Him!" When you see things that are growing, like a flower or a tree, you can remember that God wants us to grow and know Him more.

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
