SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have Magnet Blocks with Shape/Number Cards and Animal Action Dice.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. ***Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.*

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Blocks (several), Index cards (4 per group), Marker (1 per group), Gift bag (1 per group)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Thanks, Super Crew! That was so helpful! In our Bible story, we saw that Ruth was included in Naomi's family. She followed God like Naomi and became part of God's family too. Naomi and Ruth needed food and Boaz included Ruth by allowing her to gather grain in his fields. Our Super Clue is a playground. A playground is a fun place where everyone can be included. This Super Clue helps us see that God includes us too. He invites us to be part of His family and have a friendship with Him. I am so glad God gives us friends and wants us to have a friendship with Him.

Let's talk and listen to God. This is called prayer. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1.

God, thank You for including us. Thank You for inviting us to be part of Your family and to have a friendship with You. In Jesus' name, amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Jump In! (Make a small hop forward.)

God Gives Me Friends! (Bring hands together in front of you.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Gathering Grain- Craft (20 minutes)**

Preschoolers will create a grain basket craft.

Big Goal: Remember the Bible story.

Leader Prep: Cut strips of yellow paper, six to eight per child. Scatter the strips on the floor.

Supplies: Uncoated paper plates (1 per child), Brown crayons (1 per child), Yellow construction paper (several), Adult scissors (1 per group), Glue sticks (1 per child)

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, cut strips of yellow paper, six to eight per child. Scatter the strips on the floor.
2. Guide preschoolers to color a paper plate with a brown crayon.
3. Invite preschoolers to gather six to eight strips of yellow paper scattered on the floor. Mention that these strips of paper represent grain.
4. Instruct preschoolers to glue the grain to their plates. Assist as needed.
Encourage boys and girls to put glue on their plates and then press the grain to the glue.

What To Do: Let's make a craft called "Gathering Grain." Gathering what? (*Grain!*)

Yeah! In our Bible story today, we learned about how Boaz included Ruth by allowing her to gather grain in his fields. We are going to make grain baskets to help us remember our Bible story. First, I want you to color the paper plate in front of you with a brown crayon. This will be your basket. Once that is done, you can come and gather six to eight pieces of grain, which are these yellow strips of paper on the floor. Once you collect your grain, we will help you glue them in your basket.

Keep It Going: Ask preschoolers to share parts of the Bible story they remember as they glue the grain into their baskets.

Loud And Clear: Ruth and Naomi needed food to eat, so Ruth went to a field to gather grain. She gathered grain in the field of Boaz. Boaz included Ruth and helped her. God invites us to be part of His family and to have a friendship with Him.

TALK IT OUT

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*a playground*)
- What does a playground help us remember? (*A playground is a fun place where everyone can be included. **God includes us** too.*)
- Who can you include when you are at a playground?
- **God includes us.** How does God include us? (*He invites us to be part of His family and to have a friendship with Him.*)
- What did you learn about God today?
- Do you remember today's Big Deal? I'll say it first, and you say it after me (*with motions below*): Jump In! (*Jump In!*) God Gives Me Friends! (*God Gives Me Friends!*)

Keep It Going: Find a friend and include them as you say the Big Deal together using the motions. Then find another friend and say the Big Deal together.

Big Deal Motions:

Jump In! (*Make a small hop forward.*)

God Gives Me Friends! (*Bring hands together in front of you.*)

A playground is a fun place to play where everyone can be included. It is a place where all of our friends can join in and play. God gives us friends, and He includes us too. God invites us to be part of His family and to have a friendship with Him.

GOING HOME

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
