### SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS

*These questions are designed to extend the impact of the Sunday gathering. Use them to go deeper in your personal study time, with your family, and/or with your Life Group*

1. Which part of the message was most impactful for you and why? Which part of this passage is easiest for you? The hardest?
2. What do you think it means to have “a reputation of being alive” but actually be dead? What might spiritual “death” look like in a church context? Why do you think Jesus tells them to “wake up”?
3. Where might complacency quietly show up in your life? Where do you need to stoke spiritual passion? How do you do that?
4. Why is it important that Jesus points out the few who remained faithful? How can one person’s faithfulness influence others?
5. We said, “complacency is not the absence of activity, it's the absence of hunger.” What do you think? Is it possible to be doing good things, but missing the point? What is the point? How do we hunger for God?
6. What is one area that you have let your fire grow cold? Name one area where you have lost your passion for Christ. Now, what is one thing you need to do to reinvest in your deep hunger for God this week?
