

The structure of the tabernacle helps us understand and appreciate what is required to have access to God.

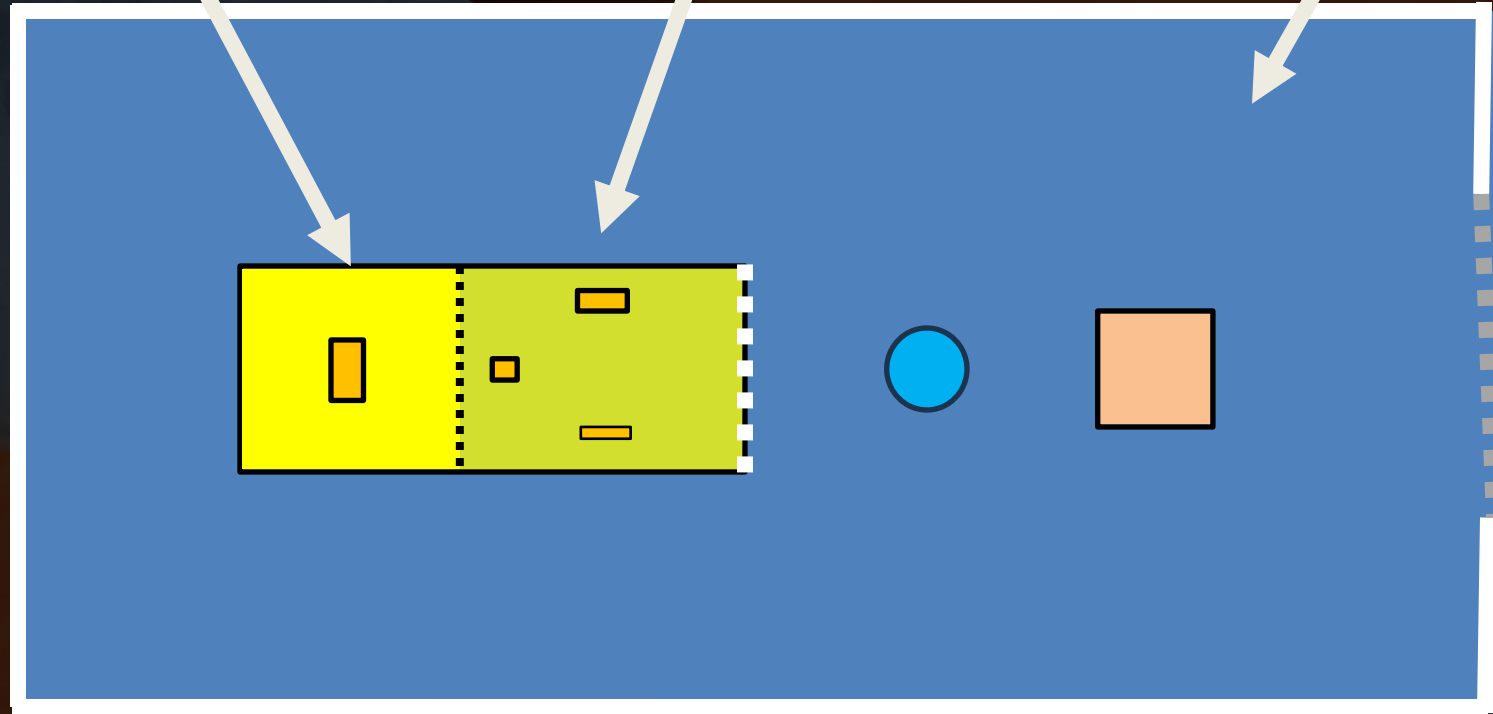
