#### CLC Social Ministry and Mission

Each month the Social Ministry highlights a special giving opportunity pertaining to hunger, homelessness/housing, or mission. March's specific emphasis provides monetary/volunteer support for the Valpo New Creation Men's Shelter/Resale Shop newcreationempowers.org + facebook.com/newcreationresaleshop New Creation (2102 N. Calumet Ave.) was created several years

ago as a center for homeless men in Valpo and Porter County. The Men's Center currently offers supportive services for homeless men year-round during daytime hours and overnights at area churches. The Resale Shop is always in need of donated furniture and appliances, household and office supplies, laundry essentials and toiletries, and cleaning supplies and paper goods.

New Creation Men's Center helps educate the community on the problem of homelessness in Porter County and on the challenges faced by clients, with the goal to create self-sufficiency. For numerous years now, from April to October, CLC members have assisted the Men's Shelter program in several ways i.e., hosting men overnight at CLC on Saturdays (Apr. -Oct.), preparing/serving meals (dinner and breakfast), and taking time to sit and talk with the men who are taking advantage of Shelter services. Along with six other churches (one each night), CLC is planning to resume the overnight program with New Creation on Saturday evening, April 15, 2023. Please see various announcements in March about how CLC folks can volunteer for time slots and/or and bring meals on Saturdays beginning soon and continuing over the summer.

## **Attention All Thrivent Financial Members!**

Do you have any *Thrivent Choice Dollars* that have not been directed to the charity of our choice?

#### Minimum and maximum Choice Dollars Designations

Eligible clients will be designated a minimum of 25 Choice Dollars and a maximum of 5,000 Choice Dollars per eligibility period (Jan. 1 to Dec. 31).

Choice Dollars designated during the calendar year can be directed until March 31, 2023.

There are two ways of directing *Choice Dollars* to Christ Lutheran Church:

**Computer:** Go to the Thrivent Financial web site (<u>www.Thrivent.com</u>) and direct

the *Choice Dollars* on-line.

**Phone:** Call Thrivent Financial at 1-800-847-4836. When prompted by the electronic answering system, say "*Thrivent Choice*." Follow the remaining prompts, and a representative will come on the line to assist you. You will need your Thrivent membership ID number and will need to answer some other personal questions to verify that you are the Thrivent member who is on the line.

# Remember to Update Your Contribution in Subsplash

A big **THANK YOU** to all who participated in our stewardship campaign! If you have changed the amount of your offering, please remember to update your contribution in Subsplash. The church office cannot do this for you. The instructions listed below will guide you through the process:

- 1. Go to our website: <a href="www.clcvalpo.org">www.clcvalpo.org</a>. Under the "Give" menu, select "Give Now." This will take you to the church's mail giving page.
- 2. In the top right corner of that page, you'll see an icon that looks like the head and shoulders of a person. Click that, and then click sign in. You will be prompted to sign into your account using email, Facebook, of Apple. Choose the option that you originally used to setup your account (for most people, that will be email).
  - •Email: Log in with your email address as your user ID and your password. If you have forgotten your password, click on "Forgot Password," and a link to reset it will be sent to your email.
  - •Facebook and Apple: You will be automatically signed in by your device.
- 3. Click the person icon at the top right of the screen, then click "Recurring Gifts." You should see your current setup displayed on the screen. Click the arrow to the right of the displayed gift. This will open a window that allows you to make any changes to your current setup.
- 4. When you are finished, be sure to scroll all the way down to the bottom and click the large purple button that says "Save and Update Gift."
