CONNECTING ACROSS GENERATIONS



At the end of the session we offered an immediate and heartfelt standing ovation.

This is a remarkable thing about Christ Lutheran: we take the gift of multiple generations very seriously. In our gathering space our youngest members are greeted by beloved friends in their 90's and 100's. Hugs are given to dear friends across generations. And when our young people command us to "Go in peace, remember the poor" we listen differently; as one member commented, "I don't want to let them down!"
