

Life Group Lesson Outline

Now My Eyes Have Seen Him Week 4

Date of sermon given: February 8, 2026

Icebreaker (10-15 minutes)

Purpose: Encourage fellowship and set a comfortable tone.

Example Questions:

- What is your high and low for the week?
- What are some things that gave you joy this week?
- What are some things that gave you sadness this week?

Lesson / Discussion (30-40 minutes)

Opening Scripture Reading: Job 13:13-28 & 23:1-17

Theme = We are walking through the book of Job seeing how God is present to Job and to us in our suffering. This week pastor Sam talks about how Job was longing for God not to “hide His face” from him. Job longed, prayed, pleaded for God to show up in his suffering. Our calling is to meet God face to face, to unveil our own hearts before him.

Question 1 = what do these passages show us about prayer? What has prayer been like in your life?

Question 2 = Has there been a time in your life where it felt like God hid his face from you? What happened and how did you respond?

Question 3 = What are some ways that you were taught to veil your face (hide your heart) in your life? Who has been a good example of vulnerability in your life and how have they invited you into being vulnerable as well?

Question 4 = If we want to know what God is like we look at Jesus. How does Jesus live and ministry affect you as you think about prayer and vulnerability with God? Take some time and sit with Romans 5:8, Isaiah 53, and John 10:17-18.

Reflection / Prayer = Take some time to pray for each other and our church.

Prayer Requests (10-30 minutes)

- Invite group members to share prayer needs. It would be good for the Leader to start this sharing time.

- Close with prayer, praying for each request. (if they are comfortable, rotate who prays for the group)
