

Christmas Eve Eve Sermon Questions

Advent Week 4 • Love

How does the Christmas story, particularly the announcement to the shepherds, demonstrate the inclusivity and unconditional nature of God's love?
How does this impact how we view ourselves and others?

What does the risk taken by the shepherds—leaving their flocks to seek Jesus—teach us about the cost of pursuing a relationship with Christ?
How can we apply their example to our lives today?

The sermon highlights that love is the foundation of hope, joy, and peace. How have you experienced God's love bringing these virtues into your life, even in challenging circumstances?

Reflecting on the genealogy of Jesus, which includes flawed individuals, how does this shape your understanding of God's ability to use imperfect people for His purposes?
How does this encourage you in your own faith journey?

The sermon suggests that familiarity with the Christmas story can sometimes cause us to overlook its profound truths. What stood out to you from this message that deepened your understanding of the Christmas story this year?

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Prayer Prompt:

Father, thank You for the gift of Your Son, Jesus, the ultimate expression of Your love for us. Help me to fully embrace the hope, joy, peace, and love that flow from Your presence and promises. Like the shepherds, give me a heart that responds to You with urgency and trust, even when it requires risk or sacrifice.

Open my eyes to the beauty of the Christmas story and remind me that Your love is for all people, including me. Use my life to reflect Your love to those around me, so they too may come to know the greatest gift ever given—Your Son, Jesus Christ.
