

Sunday Sermon Questions • 11/10/2024

Mark 7 : 24–30

The sermon emphasized the importance of having a humble heart and seeking God's presence over His provision. What are some practical ways we can shift our focus from what we want from God to simply desiring His presence in our lives?

The Gentile woman demonstrated humility by accepting Jesus' words and still pressing on with her request. How do you respond when God's answer to your prayers isn't what you expected? What can we learn from her persistence?

Jesus traveled outside of Jewish territory to a Gentile region, showing that His mission extended beyond the boundaries of Israel. How can we be more intentional in reaching out to those who may feel marginalized or overlooked in our communities?

The woman didn't demand a seat at the table but instead asked for a crumb of Jesus' power. How can we cultivate a spirit of gratitude, appreciating even the smallest blessings from God?

This story highlights how a mother's love drove her to seek help at any cost. How can we reflect this kind of sacrificial love in our relationships with others, especially when it comes to bringing them closer to Christ?

Prayer for Seeking God's Presence Over Provision

Father, help me to desire Your presence above all else. Too often, I focus on what I want from You instead of simply being with You. Teach me to seek Your face more than Your hand.
