

Sunday Sermon Questions • 11/17/2024

Mark 7 : 31-37

Reflecting on Jesus' approach in Mark 7:33-34, where He took the deaf man aside and communicated with him through gestures:

- How does Jesus' personal and compassionate interaction with the man challenge the way we approach those who are marginalized or overlooked in our society?
- What can we learn from Jesus' willingness to give this man His undivided attention?

After healing the man, Jesus instructed him and his friends to keep quiet about it...

- Has there ever been a time where you have felt Jesus asking you to do something that in the moment didn't make any sense to you?
- If so, how did you respond to what He was asking of you? Now looking back, can you see why He was asking that of you?

The sermon mentioned that being overwhelmed with emotions does not excuse disobedience to God:

- Why do you think the healed man and his friends couldn't contain themselves despite Jesus' clear instruction?
- How do our emotions sometimes interfere with our ability to follow God's guidance, and how can we better align our actions with His will?
