Staying Spiritually Alert

Faith in the Face of Fear

Jesus promised that the Holy Spirit would give believers the words to say during persecution. How can this truth help us overcome fear or hesitation when opportunities arise to share our faith?

Suffering and the Call to Follow

The sermon reminded us that following Jesus often involves suffering rather than comfort. How does this challenge the idea of the “American dream,” and how can we embrace a faith that is willing to endure hardship for the sake of the gospel?

Living with Eternal Urgency

If we truly lived as though Jesus could return today, what might change about the way we prioritize our time, relationships, and resources?

Being Ready and Helping Others Be Ready

Jesus called His followers not only to be ready but also to help others be ready for His return. What are some practical ways we can live out this mission in our homes, workplaces, and communities?
