EXPECTANT *Stories of Legends & Legacies of Faith*

Trust and Obedience: The widow in 1 Kings 17 trusted Elijah's words and obeyed God's instruction, even when it seemed risky. What are some areas in your life where God may be calling you to trust Him in a similar way?

First Fruits and Faith: Elijah instructed the widow to give him a portion of her last meal before feeding herself and her son. How does this relate to the concept of giving God our first fruits? How can we apply this principle to our own finances, time, or talents?

Expectant Faith: The widow gave in faith, expecting God to provide. What does it mean to have Expectant Faith in your life? Can you share a time when you stepped out in faith and saw God provide?

God's Provision: The widow's flour and oil never ran out, showing God's faithfulness. How have you seen God provide in unexpected ways in your own life?

Breaking Fear and Scarcity Mindsets: Elijah told the widow, Do not be afraid. How does fear impact our ability to trust and obey God? What steps can we take to shift from a scarcity mindset (fear of not having enough) to a faith mindset (trusting in God's provision)?

Prayer Prompt:

Heavenly Father, thank You for being a God who sees our needs and provides in ways we cannot imagine. Help us to trust You like the widow trusted Elijah. Give us the faith to step out in obedience, even when it seems difficult. Teach us to offer You our first and our best, knowing that You are our ultimate provider. Break any fear or scarcity mindset in our hearts, and fill us with the confidence that You are always faithful. Let our lives reflect an expectant faith that brings You glory. In Jesus' name, Amen.
