EXPECTANT *Stories of Legends & Legacies of Faith*

Faithful Stewardship: Caleb followed the Lord wholeheartedly, even when others doubted. What does it mean to be a faithful steward of what God has entrusted to us? How can we apply that to our time, talents, and treasures?

Trusting God's Timing: The church leadership had been praying for years for the right property, and God provided at the perfect time. Can you share a time in your life when God answered a long-awaited prayer? How did that experience strengthen your faith?

Obedience in Action: Caleb boldly asked for the land God had promised him, despite the obstacles ahead (Joshua 14:12). What are some obstacles that might keep us from stepping into God's promises? How can we overcome them?

Corporate Vision and Individual Role: The church is collectively seeking the Lord's guidance on how to develop the new property. What do you think it means for individuals to seek their specific role within a larger vision? How can we discern God's call for us in this season?

Generosity and Trust: Over the last 3 weeks we have been able to see the young boy with five loaves and two fish, the widow with her last bit of flour and oil, and Mary with her expensive perfume, display a willingness to sacrificially offer that which they had to the Lord. How does their example challenge you in regards to your willingness to give to the Lord, as it relates to your time, talent, and treasure?

Lord, thank You for Your faithfulness in leading us as a church and as individuals. Just as You guided Caleb, You are guiding us now. Help us to trust Your timing, to step forward in obedience, and to give with a heart of faith. Reveal to us how we can use our time, talents, and treasures to further Your kingdom. May we have the boldness to say, Lord, here I am! Use me! In Jesus' name, Amen.
