Covenant

Understanding Covenants:

The sermon explains that a covenant is a solemn and binding agreement. How does understanding the significance of a covenant deepen your understanding of God's promises throughout Scripture? What does it mean to you personally that God made a covenant with Abraham, knowing Abraham (like all of us) would fail to uphold his part?

Trusting God's Promises:

Abram believed God's promise despite circumstances that seemed impossible. Have you ever experienced a time when you struggled to trust God's timing or His promises? How did you respond? How can Abram's example inspire you to trust God even when the outcome is unclear?

God's Faithfulness in Doubt:

Even after Abram was credited as righteous for believing God, he still expressed doubt. How does this reveal God's grace in our moments of uncertainty? Can you recall a time when you doubted God yet experienced His faithfulness?

God's Role in the Covenant:

The sermon compares God's role in the covenant to a clutch player taking the final shot. How does it impact you to know that God Himself signed the covenant, ensuring its fulfillment even at great cost? How does this truth shape your understanding of Jesus' sacrifice on the cross?

Living in Response to the Covenant:

Knowing that Jesus paid the ultimate price to fulfill God's promise, what steps can you take this week to live in gratitude and obedience to Him? What areas of your life are you holding back from trusting God with fully?

Prayer Prompt:

Father God, thank You for Your unwavering love and for fulfilling the covenant we could never uphold. Thank You for Jesus, who bore the cost so that we might be saved. Help us to trust You in moments of doubt, to walk in obedience even when the path seems uncertain, and to rest in the truth that Your promises never fail. Grow in us a heart that reflects Your faithfulness and a life that honors the covenant You made.
