Covenant

How Do You See God?

When you think about God, do you view Him more as a rule-giver or a loving Father? How has your personal experience, upbringing, or church background influenced that view?

Why Did God Act Before He Spoke?

Why do you think God demonstrated His faithfulness through provision, protection, and miracles before giving the Israelites the Ten Commandments? What does this reveal about His heart?

Rules Without Relationship

What does the phrase “Rules without relationship will always lead to rebellion” mean to you? Have you seen this principle play out in your relationship with God, your family, or others?

Fulfilled, Not Forgotten

Jesus said He did not come to abolish the Law but to fulfill it (Matthew 5:17). What does that mean for us today as believers? How should we approach God’s commands in light of what Jesus has done?

From Obligation to Intimacy

What’s one way you can deepen your relationship with God this week so that obedience flows from love rather than duty? What might be getting in the way of seeing Him as trustworthy and good?

Prayer Prompt:

Father, help me see You as You truly are—a good, loving, and trustworthy God. Thank You for demonstrating Your love and faithfulness before ever asking for my obedience. Help me to walk in relationship with You, not out of duty, but out of love and trust. Thank You for sending Jesus to fulfill what I could never do on my own. Teach me to follow Your ways with joy, knowing they are for my good and for Your glory. Draw me close and transform how I see You. Amen.
