

Sunday Sermon Questions • 3/9/2025

Mark 9 : 2 – 13

The Supremacy of Christ: The Father's declaration — "This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to Him!" — emphasized Jesus' ultimate authority. How does understanding the supremacy of Christ impact the way you live your daily life and make decisions?

Moments of Awe and Fear: When Peter, James, and John experienced the transfiguration, they were overwhelmed and fearful, yet Jesus comforted them. Can you recall a time when you felt overwhelmed or fearful in God's presence? How did Jesus' peace meet you in that moment?

Listening to Jesus: The Father's instruction was clear: "Listen to Him!" What are some practical ways you can better tune your heart and mind to hear and obey Jesus' voice in your daily routine?

Proclaiming the Gospel: Jesus told the disciples not to share what they had seen until after His resurrection. Today, we are commissioned to share the Good News. What challenges do you face when sharing your faith, and how can understanding Christ's supremacy help you overcome them?

Living with Gratitude: Reflecting on the disciples' experience on the mountain, how can you cultivate a deeper sense of gratitude for Jesus' sacrifice and victory? What changes might you need to make to reflect that gratitude in your relationships, work, or community?

Prayer Prompt:

Father, thank You for revealing Jesus' glory and reminding us to listen to Him. Help us to fix our eyes on Jesus, trusting in His power and compassion. When we feel overwhelmed, comfort us with His peace. Give us boldness to share His love and live with grateful hearts. In Jesus' name, Amen.
