Covenant • Palm Sunday

Reflecting on the Cross:

Colossians 2:13–15 speaks of our debts being nailed to the cross. What “debts” or burdens do you personally need to lay down today?

Preparing Our Hearts:

1 Corinthians 11:27–28 reminds us to examine ourselves before taking communion. How can we approach the Lord’s Supper with a heart of humility and gratitude?

Boldness in the Gospel:

The lyrics from “The Kingdom Come” ask God to fill us with courage and boldness. Where in your life is God calling you to step out in boldness for the sake of the gospel?

The Posture of Worship:

Foot washing is a powerful symbol of servanthood. What does it mean to live a life of worship and humility in your daily relationships?

Revival and Healing:

When you hear the words “God send revival” and “stretch out Your hand for healing and wonders,” what do you imagine that would look like in your life or in our church? How can we make space for God to move like that?

Prayer Prompt:

Lord, we come before You with hearts open to Your Spirit. Fill us with boldness to carry Your gospel. Cleanse us as we reflect on the sacrifice of Jesus. Let Your revival stir within us and pour out over our families, our city, and the nations. May we walk humbly, love deeply, and worship You in spirit and truth. Bring healing, bring freedom, bring Heaven down. Amen.
