Covenant • Easter Sunday

Born Again:

What does it mean to be "born again," and how does Jesus' conversation with Nicodemus help us understand this concept on a deeper level? Reflect on the difference between knowing about Jesus and being transformed by Him.

Knowledge vs. Belief:

Nicodemus was a respected religious leader, yet he struggled to understand Jesus' message. What does this tell us about the difference between religious knowledge and spiritual revelation? How can we guard against merely "knowing" and instead live a life of "believing"?

The Bronze Snake

Jesus used the imagery of the bronze snake from Numbers 21 to explain His crucifixion. Why is this comparison so powerful, and how does it help us grasp the seriousness of sin and the beauty of salvation?

Where Are Your Eyes?

In what ways are you tempted to fix your eyes on things of the world—success, family, comfort—instead of fixing your eyes on Jesus? What changes might God be prompting you to make?

Receiving the Gospel:

Read John 3:16–18 aloud. What does this passage stir in you personally? How can you share this message with someone who might only "know the facts" but hasn't yet encountered the transforming love of Jesus?

Prayer Prompt:

Jesus, You are the only One worthy of our focus, our trust, and our lives. Thank You for making a way for us to be born again—born of the Spirit—so that we might have eternal life. Forgive us for the times we've fixed our eyes on things that cannot save us. Help us to daily turn our hearts toward You, to fully trust in the work of the cross, and to live in the power of the resurrection. May Your Spirit guide us, change us, and lead us to share Your love with others. Amen.
