## Mark 10:1-12

### Truth vs. Trap

What stood out to you most about Jesus' response to the Pharisees' question on divorce? How does His response challenge or affirm your own views on marriage?

### The Heart of the Matter

Jesus pointed to the "hardness of heart" as the reason Moses allowed divorce—how do you think hardness of heart shows up in relationships today? How can we guard against it in our own hearts?

### Culture vs. Covenant

In what ways has culture distorted or devalued the biblical meaning of marriage? How can believers hold firm to God's design while showing grace?

### Marriage as a Mirror

How does viewing marriage through the lens of Christ and the Church shape our understanding of commitment and covenant? What difference should this perspective make in our daily lives?

### Walking It Out

If you are married, how can you better reflect Christ in your marriage this week?  
If you're not married, how can you support and encourage marriages around you in the body of Christ?

Lord, thank You for Your perfect design for marriage. Help me to see marriage the way You do—as a sacred covenant, not a casual commitment. Soften any hardened places in my heart, and heal the wounds that distort my understanding of love and relationship. Whether I am married or single, help me to reflect Your faithfulness in all my relationships. Give me the courage to uphold Your truth and the compassion to walk with others in grace. Strengthen me to be a witness to the beauty of Your design.
