Mark 10:32–45

The Weight of the Cross

How do you personally react to Jesus' prediction of His suffering and death in this passage? What does it reveal about His mission, and what does it ask of us as His followers?

Ambition in the Wrong Moment

Why do you think James and John were still focused on status and power, even after hearing Jesus' prediction? Can you relate to their desire to be seen, promoted, or honored? Why or why not?

Fame vs. Faithfulness

How does our culture's obsession with fame and influence challenge Jesus' call to humility and servanthood? Are there any areas where you've been influenced by "celebrity Christianity" or worldly status?

Counting the Cost

Jesus tells the disciples, "You don't know what you are asking."
Have you ever prayed for something or chased a dream without fully understanding what it would cost you spiritually, emotionally, or relationally?

Prayer Prompt:

Jesus, I confess that I often seek recognition, comfort, and influence over humility and service. Help me to follow Your example—to be last, to serve, to love without needing to be noticed. Teach me to be content in quiet faithfulness. Give me courage to carry my cross, even when it's uncomfortable or costly. May I become less so You may become more.
